Next Sunday we, along with Anabaptist churches around the world, will celebrate **Anabaptist World Fellowship Sunday**. We mark this occassion each January on the day when the first recorded adult baptism and break from the municipal church took place. This year is the 500th anniversary of that date. In recognition of this, we have received donations for the newly published *Anabaptist Community Study Bible* which will replace our current pew Bibles. We will dedicate our new Bibles during the service.
